Square Roots

$$\sqrt[2]{7} + \sqrt[2]{7} = 2\sqrt[2]{7}$$

Like Radicals: Add or subtract coefficients.

$$x + x = 2x$$


5.29 = 5.29



Like Radicals: Same radicand, same index

$$1\sqrt[2]{3} + 1\sqrt[2]{3} = 2\sqrt[2]{3}$$

$$3.46 = 3.46$$



$$2\sqrt[2]{3} + 5\sqrt[2]{3} = 7\sqrt[2]{3}$$



$$\sqrt[2]{3} + \sqrt[2]{2} = \sqrt[2]{3} + \sqrt[2]{2}$$

Cannot add/subtract unlike radicals. Can only add/subtract like radicals.

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2)

$$\sqrt[2]{3} + \sqrt[2]{2} = 1.71 + 1.41 = 3.15$$


$$4\sqrt[2]{2} - 7\sqrt[2]{2} = -3\sqrt[2]{2}$$
$$-4.24 = -4.24$$


Simplify Roots

$$\sqrt[2]{12} + \sqrt[2]{27} + \sqrt[2]{18} + 5$$
$$2\sqrt[2]{3} + 3\sqrt[2]{3} + 3\sqrt[2]{2} + 5$$

$$5\sqrt[2]{3} + 3\sqrt[2]{2} + 5$$

$$17.9 = 17.9$$





Cube Roots

$$\sqrt[3]{7} + \sqrt[3]{7} = 2\sqrt[3]{7}$$

$$\sqrt[3]{5} + \sqrt[3]{5} = 2\sqrt[3]{5}$$

$$3.42 = 3.42$$

$$-2\sqrt[3]{5} - 6\sqrt[3]{5} = -8\sqrt[3]{5}$$

$$-13.68 = -13.68$$

$$\sqrt[3]{3} + 1 = \sqrt[3]{3} + 1$$

Can only add or subtract like radicals.
